GIFT AND INVITATION CARD



Bahá'ís and Clusters that are ready and are at the point of wanting to reach out beyond the circle of Bahá'ís to the general public in a systematic and organized way, can use this simple tool.

The gift and invitation card can be used as a "golden key" to open the door and to reach the masses, when it is taken personally by the friends to the people in their neighborhoods, or given to their friends, co-workers etc., as a gift of prayers and prophecy of Isaiah, and invitation to the core activities. It should not be mailed or indiscriminately given out to anybody. This card should be used as a key to find the waiting souls, to open the door to interested people, to invite them to the core activities, or to have home visits with them.

This should only be given to those who would like to have them, and it needs to be mentioned to them to keep it on their desk, fireplace, or special place, or share it with the people of similar interest. It can also be used as a book marker.

This is printed on a 6 X 9 card, folded in the middle; one side is the Shrine of the Báb and the words of Isaiah and the three prayers, and the other side has information about devotions, study circles, children and junior youth classes, and the invitation information.



NOTES ON ISAIAH'S PROPHESY



It took us over 147 years, so many martyrs and so much untold sacrifices and efforts, before we Bahá'ís are able to build and bring into reality what Bahá'u'lláh has brought us. The throne of God mentioned in the Tablet of Carmel ("God hath in this Day established upon thee His throne" and "He, verily, loveth the spot which hath been made the seat of His throne") is what Isaiah has prophesied, that is, the "LORD'S house, shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it. And many peoples shall go and say: 'Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of


the God of Jacob", which is seen in the picture so clearly.

The next part of the prophecy, on which we are presently working and are trying to share with the people by this invitation, is "He will teach us of His ways, and we will walk in His paths". This is what we Bahá'ís all over the world are so patiently building, with our institute process and core activities, and Bahá'u'lláh through His infallible Universal House of Justice is guiding us to accomplish. That is what we can tell people; that is why they need to come to those study circles to find "His Way", the Way of God, and to walk in His paths, as Isaiah prophesied. For if we do that, we will come to see the next part of the prophecy which will be "they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks; nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more". Then we emphasize to the prospective Bahá'ís to see as how important it is for every one to come to those core activities. And it helps us Bahá'ís to press on, undeterred. **The choice is ours**.

Baha'u'llah "decreed and imposed upon every one the obligation to teach this Cause..." He urged, "Go thou straight on and persevere in His service. Say: O people! The Day, promised unto you in all the Scriptures, is now come." (Gleanings, p. 314)

Beloved Guardian wrote, "Undaunted by the perils and the uncertainties of the present hour, the American believers must press on and prosecute in its entirety the task which now confronts them. I pray for their success from the depths of my heart." (July 28, 1936)

The Universal House of Justice, in their Ridván 2002 message, concluded, "Unhampered by any doubts, unhindered by any obstacles, press on, then, with the Plan in hand."



The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem, "And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the mountain of the LORD's house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it. And many people shall go and say: Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; and He will teach us of His ways, and we will walk in His paths: For out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem. And He shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people: and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more."
